- 2) Please be sure to pay the registration fee within 72 hours after completing the online registration. If you do not pay the registration fee by the deadline, the system will cancel your registration. A credit card is required to pay the registration fee.
- 3) The registration is valid for both onsite and web meetings.
- 4) The registration fee includes: Admission to all scientific sessions of JRS/JSRT and the exhibition hall (ITEM).
- 5) When attending the venue, please log in to the service counter specified in the completion confirmation email in advance. Print out your name card and bring it with you to the venue. The name card holder can be obtained by exchanging it for attendance confirmation at the JSMP desk in Exhibition Hall A. - 5) Please follow the time schedule for the presentation as shown below;

4. Instructions for Moderators at Oral Sessions

- 1) Chairpersons are requested to check in at the Registration Desk at the session venue at least 10 minutes prior to the session start time.
- 2) Each presentation is 10 minutes long consisting of 7 minutes oral presentation and 3 minutes discussion including the time needed to change to the next presenter.
- 3) A colored light box is placed in front of the chairperson and presenter to indicate the time remaining for the presentation. The yellow light indicates that the presenter has only one minute remaining in his/her presentation time. The red light indicates the end of the presenter's presentation time.
- 4) Sessions may proceed at the discretion of the chairperson, but try to adhere strictly to the time schedule.
